

Smt. Nimuben Jayantibhai Bambhaniya, Hon'ble Minister of State for Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, began her political journey as a grassroots worker with the BJP, alongside serving as a dedicated educator. Rising from the booth level to Mandal, District, and State leadership, she demonstrated deep commitment to public service. She has also been actively involved with several NGOs.

Her formal political career began in 2005 when she was elected Corporator of Ghogha Circle Ward No. 13, a position she held until 2020. She served as Mayor of Bhavnagar Municipal Corporation (2009–2010, 2015–2018) and held key leadership roles, including Director of Gujarat Thakor and Koli Vikas Nigam, Gandhinagar (2011-2016), Vice President of Bhavnagar City (2008-2010), President of Bhavnagar City Mahila Morcha (2009-2011), Vice President of Gujarat State (2011-2013) and Vice President of Gujarat State Mahila Morcha (2013-2021)

Recognized for her leadership, the BJP entrusted her as Prabhari of several districts, including Amreli, Surendranagar, Bhavnagar, and Junagadh. She also served as BJP Nirakshak in Gujarat, overseeing local state assembly elections.

In the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, she won the Bhavnagar (Gujarat) seat, reflecting strong grassroots support. Currently, she serves as Minister of State for Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution in Prime Minister Narendra Modi's government.
